<b>COURSE OBJECTIVES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Describe the Incident Command System (ICS).</li> <li>• Describe the various ways ICS can be applied.</li> <li>• Define the role of an executive/senior official relative to the ICS.</li> <li>• Describe the major responsibilities of an executive/senior official as related to an incident.</li> <li>• Demonstrate basic familiarity with ICS terminology.</li> <li>• Describe the basic organization of ICS and know the functional responsibilities of the Command and General Staffs.</li> <li>• Describe issues that influence incident complexity and the tools available to analyze complexity.</li> <li>• Describe the differences between on-incident ICS organizations and activities and the activities accomplished by Emergency Operations Centers (EOCs), Area Commands, and Multi-Agency Coordination Systems (MACS).</li> <li>• Explain the administrative, logistical, financial, and reporting implications of large incident operations.</li> <li>• Describe the sources of information regarding the incident and how to access them.</li> <li>• Describe types of agency(ies) policies and guidelines that influence management of incident or event activities.</li> </ul>
