<b>COURSE DESCRIPTION</b>	2-Day Course. The Incident Command System (ICS) is the national standard to manage emergency incidents and critical events, and is a key component of NIMS. This course expands upon the information covered in ICS 100, ICS 200, and ICS 300 courses and is for personnel who require advanced application of the Incident Command System. The course will satisfy state training requirements for incident responders.

<b>TARGET AUDIENCE</b>	As part of NIMS compliance requirements, the primary audience for this course is senior response personnel, <u>regardless of discipline</u> , who are expected to perform in the management capacity in an Incident Command, Area Command or Multiagency Coordination (MAC) and be required to fill a role as Incident Commander, Command Staff or General Staff within the Incident Command System during larger incidents. These groups include first responders, state/local government and agencies, emergency management personnel, Non-Governmental Organizations, private sector businesses and local civic organizations.
