DE IMT MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Delaware All-Hazards Incident Management Team (DE IMT) is to provide personnel who are trained, experienced and certified as incident management specialists and organized to assist, support and coordinate emergency response, incident recovery or planned special event operations within the State of Delaware

CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

The State of Delaware will develop a Type III IMT to provide 24 hour incident management operations. The DE IMT will:

- Serve at the discretion of the Director of DEMA.
- Deploy only when an official request is made to the Director of DEMA and the Director approves deployment.
- Will serve under the command and control of the host jurisdiction upon deployment.
- Be trained and certified to a Type 3 level for response to local up through and including regional jurisdictional emergencies and preplanned events.

- Integrate into the affected jurisdiction's ICS structure. The DE IMT is not intended to assume command and control of the incident but solely to coordinate and support response/recovery operations at the level(s) of operation.
- Attain qualification in primary and secondary positions.
- Be deployable within 6 hours of a request.
- Deploy with team equipment and sufficient food and water supplies to be self-sustainable for a minimum of 72 hours.
- Join DEMA to assist county and Local EMAs establish their own Type 4 level IMTs upon request of those agencies.

The key to this program is the support of state and local response agencies. All members of the DE IMT must obtain cooperation and agreement from their own agency/supervisors to join.

In return for the individual's agency support to make the DE IMT member available during an incident, the DE IMT will provide and fund team members with the knowledge, skills and abilities in two or more of the positions listed below. These valuable skills are a source that an individual's agency can use every day of the year.
