COURSE DESCRIPTION	This course trains local government positions and allied professionals to increase their awareness of issues involved in disaster recovery. It provides a forum for discussion of “lessons learned” in disaster recovery at the local level, and promotes the development of a pre-disaster recovery plan. The course delivery method consists of lectures, case study activities, discussions, and exercises.
