<b>COURSE OBJECTIVES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explain the course structure and potential ICS/EOC interface challenges.</li> <li>• Explain key NIMS concepts, command and coordination systems, and structures.</li> <li>• Analyze given scenarios to determine commonalities and potential interface issues between ICS and EOCs.</li> <li>• Explain the respective roles and interconnectivity of the NIMS command and coordination systems in coordination.</li> <li>• Contrast the typical role and functions of the Incident Command and the EOC during emergency operations.</li> <li>• Analyze given scenarios to apply ICS/EOC interface concepts.</li> <li>• Develop an ICS/EOC interface action plan for your community.</li> </ul>
